Note on SB 1032

Senate Bill 1032 was signed by the governor so Texas residents will need to get a provisional license starting on **September 1, 2011**. You will need:

- ◆ proof of 280 hours of completion from an equine dentistry school
- ◆ 3 notarized affidavits from Texas equine professionals
- ◆ 3 letters of recommendations from Texas veterinarians
