



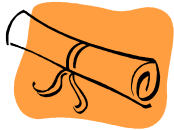
T.I.E.D. Talk

ADVANCED CLASSES

On October 4th, 5th, & 6th, **T.I.E.D.** will hold it's first advanced class apart from our regular class session. The structure will be as follows: If you would like to take an intensive, personalized advance session, working directly with Randy on a one on one basis, we will now offer an individual advanced session for 3 days in length. This session will be offered in-between our normal class sessions. It is open to all graduated **T.I.E.D.** students at the cost of \$100.00 per day. We are also offering these individualized sessions to any Equine Dental school student who may wish to transfer as well as any Veterinarian who may wish to learn an advanced form of Equine Dentistry. The transfer fee and/or a first time Veterinarian fee will be \$1500.00 for the first session. Once you have become an established student of **T.I.E.D.**, the fee will be \$100.00 per day for each additional session.

If you would like to continue with our courtesy classes, you may still sign up as an advanced student and attend a normal class session for free if you wish. Please note, these will be strictly limited to 4 advanced students per class session and no exceptions will be made.

If you want to sign up for an optional wetlab or attend for advanced hours, you must notify the office no later than 2 weeks prior to the beginning of our class session.
